<p><b>OHS Meeting Update and Tour of School:</b>            Correspondence with photos of bathroom issues send, but no response yet from SSRCE.</p>	Daphne to follow up.
<p><b>Student Council Update:</b>            Council has not met recently.</p>	
<p><b>SAC Funds:</b>            -Need clarification whether HST Rebate from SAC purchases are returned to the SAC fund balance.            -SAC confirmed expenditure for Heritage Fair expenses (approx. \$200), including costs for lunch for volunteer judges, medals for winners, etc. This is the first year the school has these expenses given we now include grades 5/6.            -Grant for Classroom Conditions has been sought to enhance student engagement and success for Exploratory Days giving students activities outside of school (LCLC, Superstore, athletic facilities, HB Studio, bowling, On Tap dance studio, etc); April 16 for grades 7-9, May 17 for grades 5/6. In case grant funding is not obtained, SAC pre-approves the expenditure for these (approx. \$1600), given the benefits the Exploratory Days for the whole student body, albeit while significantly limiting our ability to fund the remaining requests of teachers on the “wish list” of items being considered for funding from SAC monies.            -Daphne confirmed that past SAC contributions to grade nine recognition ceremony expenses were not needed and that there is no plan to do Super Projects school-wide in June, thus freeing up some of our anticipated expenses.</p>	Daphne to confirmed return of HST Rebate funds to our SAC account relative to SAC expenditures.
